

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2004 – 01

AN ORDER CREATING “TASK FORCE: SANTE TODO LINIS” OF THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA AND ENJOINING PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SECTORS OF THE SOCIETY TO OBSERVE CLEANLINESS AT ALL TIMES.

Whereas, rampant disregard for the implementation of City Ordinance No. 2002-002 otherwise known as the City of San Fernando Ecological Waste Management Ordinance has been observed;

Whereas, unhampered and indiscriminate disposal of garbage is causing an unsightly and unhealthy surroundings for the City of San Fernando, Pampanga;

Whereas, the city government recognizes the need to inform the public of their prime responsibility to maintaining a healthy, clean environment that respects for the future of the next generation;

I further enjoin private and public sectors of the City of San Fernando to observe cleanliness at all times:

FUNCTIONS

- a. Monitor and enforce the strict implement of the City Ordinance No. 2002-002 and all other City Ordinance pertaining to waste management;
- b. Initiate tl18 public to actively participate in programs whose end is to achieve a healthy and dirt free environment through a substantial information and education dissemination;
- c. As deputized enforcers of the ordinances related to waste management, identify violators and apprehend individuals and cite the same corresponding penalty / charge them in court;

- d. Make the necessary recommendation to proper authority; and
- e. Other functions that may be deemed necessary for the purpose of achieving a clean and healthy environment.
