

Executive Order 2004-03

AN ORDER CREATING THE SAN FERNANDO WOMEN'S DAY 2004 EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AND APPOINTING ITS MEMBERS HEREOF

Whereas, September 10, 2003 and every year hereafter was declared as San Fernando Women's Day in commemoration of the birth anniversary of Nicolasa P. Dayrit, one of the Women of the Philippine Revolution;

Whereas, there is an inherent need to honor her for her high sense of patriotism and outstanding contributions to the entire nation;

Whereas, there is no honor more fitting than a meaningful celebration on the said day that will promote the rights and welfare of women in the City of San Fernando;

Whereas, her remains will be returned to the City of San Fernando on that day, and as such, preparations must be done to render proper protocol and military honors during the high noon reburial in a monument being prepared in her honor;

Now, therefore, by the powers vested in me by law, I, Atty. Oscar S. Rodriguez, City Mayor of the City of San Fernando, do hereby create the San Fernando Women's Day 2004 Executive Committee and appoint its members hereof:
