

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2004 – 06

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING THE COMMITTEE THAT WILL IMPLEMENT ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 103

WHEREAS, the President of the Republic of the Philippines, through the Acting Executive Secretary Eduardo R. Ermita, issued Administrative Order No. 103 on 31 August 2004 directing the continued adoption and implementation of austerity measures in the government in order to meet the country's fiscal targets, maintain its macroeconomic stability and improve investor confidence.

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the administrative order provides that local governments are strongly urged to adopt the provisions thereof.

WHEREAS, the city of government of San Fernando, Pampanga adopts the provisions of Administrative Order No. 103 and acknowledges the need for the implementation of austerity measures in the local government unit in order to attain the fiscal targets and stability envisioned by the 10-Point Legacy Agenda.

WHEREAS, there is a need to create a committee and appoint the members thereof that will adopt measures and guidelines in the implementation of austerity measures in the local government unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, by the powers vested in me, I, OSCAR S. RODRIGUEZ, City Mayor of the City of San Fernando, Pampanga, do hereby create the herein committee that will have for its functions the adoption of guidelines for the implementation of austerity measures in the local government unit, and hereby appoint the following as its members:

2. Engr. FERDINAND Z. CAYLAO - City Administrator
3. Mr. OSCAR P. PARUNGAO - City Treasurer
4. Ms. GISEL P. RIVERA - City Accountant
5. Mr. ANTONIO M. CANLAS - City Budget Officer

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
