

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. CM02005 - 017

AN ORDER ENJOINING CITY OFFICES TO ORGANIZE RELATED ACTIVITIES IN CELEBRATION OF THE 4TH ANNUAL SAN FERNANDO WOMEN'S DAY.

WHEREAS, September 10 has been declared as San Fernando Women's Day in recognition of the significant role of Nicolasa Dayrit Y Panlilio, whose birth day falls on this day, in safeguarding and protecting the revolutionaries during the Spanish Occupation and other unnamed Kapampangan women who made important contributions to nation-building and in shaping our society;

WHEREAS, in order to ascertain a meaningful celebration that will increase the consciousness of the Femandinos on the spirit of the struggles of Nicolasa Dayrit and perpetuate her cause, encourage women to contribute to nation-building and develop a awareness on the significant role of women in society, offices in the city government are mandated to utilize all resources available to them;

WHEREAS, it is found most appropriate that the theme of this year's celebration is "Continuing the Legacy of Nicolasa Dayrit, A Celebration of Women's Struggle for Nationhood;

NOW, THEREFORE. By the powers vested in me by law, 1, Oscar S. Rodriguez, Mayor of the City of San Fernando, do hereby order as follows:

Section 1. The following offices shall organize and implement activities that will highlight tile theme and the spirit of Women's Day:

1. Trade, Industry and Tourism Office (TITO)
2. Gender and Development Office (GAD)
3. Public Affairs and Media Production Unit (PAMPU)
4. City Schools Division
5. City Social Welfare and Development (CSWD)
6. City Health Office (CHO)
7. Philippine National Police-CSFP (PNP)

Section 2. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
