

## **ORDINANCE NO. 2004 - 008**

### **AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM INCREASE OF FIFTY CENTAVOS AND MAXIMUM OF P1.00 PER KILOMETER PER PASSENGER TO THE EXISTING TRICYCLE FARE WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA.**

The Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of San Fernando, Pampanga in session assembled do ordain that:

**Section 1. Title** - This Ordinance shall be known and cited as:  
**“THE TRICYCLE FARE ORDINANCE OF 2004 OF THE CITY OF SAN FERNANDO, PAMPANGA.**

**Section 2. Coverage** - This Ordinance shall find application only in the Local Government Unit (LGU) of the City of San Fernando, Pampanga’s 35 barangays:

**Section 3. Purpose.** - This Ordinance is enacted for the following purposes:

1. To prescribe a uniform tricycle fare in the City of San Fernando, Pampanga’s 35 barangays;
2. To provide a reasonable tricycle fare among commuters;
3. To protect commuters against unscrupulous tricycle drivers and provide guidelines among the latter in the enforcement of a uniform tricycle fare in the city;
4. To provide a reasonable increase to tricycle drivers and operators to cope with the existing increase of petroleum products;

**Section 4. Penalty Provision.** - The following penalties shall be imposed on any or all violators of this Ordinance:

**1. For First Offense** - Any tricycle driver or operator or both who violates this Ordinance for the first time shall be fined the amount of P2,000.00 and or confiscation of driver’s license or both at the discretion of the apprehending authorities;

**2. For Second Offense** - Any tricycle driver or operator who violates this Ordinance for the second time shall be fined the amount of P3,000.00 and or confiscation of driver’s license or both with a stern warning that the repetition of the same offense shall consequence to the revocation of the operator’s franchise;

**3. For Third Offense** - Any tricycle driver or operator who violates this Ordinance for the third time or more shall be fined the amount of P5,000.00 and or confiscation of a driver’s license or both and the confiscation of the operator’s franchise.

**Section 3. Repealing Clause** - Local Ordinances, Resolutions, Orders, Rules and Regulations that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.

**Section 4. Separability Clause** - If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional and or illegal, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected and shall therefore, be in full force and effect.

**Section 5. Effectivity Clause** - This Ordinance shall take effect upon satisfaction of its required publication for three consecutive issues in a newspaper of general circulation in the Province of Pampanga and the posting of the same in conspicuous places of the City Hall.
